

Year 2 Class Newsletter



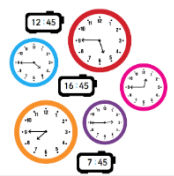
Term: Autumn Term 1

Welcome back! We hope you have had a restful break and are ready for another year ahead.

English This term in English, we will look at both fiction and non-fiction texts, as well as continue to develop basic punctuation and grammar skills. Phonics and spellings will continue to be taught focusing on revising set 2 and set 3 sounds.



Mathematics: In Mathematics we will be tackling:
Place Value including reading, writing and ordering numbers
Addition and subtraction
Counting on and back in 1s, 2s and 10s within one hundred.
Number bonds to 10, 20 and 100



Science:

In Science this term, our topic is 'Animals including Humans'. We will be learning about growth, life cycles, hygiene and what animals need to survive.

Humanities: In Humanities, we will start with our History topic, 'Time to Explore'. We will develop our understanding of historical concepts such as chronology as well as looking at how people's lives and events have shaped the nation and the world.

PE: Our PE days are Monday and Wednesday. In PE this term, we will be developing our football skills and practising our multiskills. Weather permitting, football will take place outdoors for which your child will need trainers, a plain sweatshirt and plain joggers. Please check all PE kit is named and all jewellery, including watches and earrings, need to be removed for all PE lessons.

Other subjects: In RE, we will learn about how and why some people pray, with a focus on Christianity and Islam. In Computing, we will focus on the use of IT in the world around us.

How you can help at home:

- Home Learning is set on Google classroom on Thursday to be returned by the following Monday.
- Use Google Classroom to submit completed home learning if preferred.
- Login to TTRockstars regularly to develop times table skills and fluency.
- Learn and recall quickly number bonds to 10.
- Ensure your child reads regularly to an adult. By reading with your child, you are not just helping them to develop their fluency but also their understanding and inference skills.
- Practise reading and spelling 5 new words from the Year Two common exception word list each week. This is available on the school website.
- Talk to your children about how they can raise their independence and resilience.
