

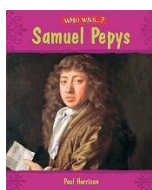
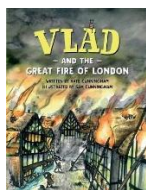
Year 2 Class Newsletter



Term: Autumn Term 2

Topic: Fire

English This term in English, we will look at poetry and report writing as well as continuing to develop basic punctuation and grammar skills. Phonics and spellings will also continue to be taught.



Mathematics: In Mathematics we will be tackling:



Addition and subtraction
Number bonds
Naming and describing properties of 2D and 3D shapes
Counting on and back in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s

Science:

In Science this term, our topic is 'Materials'. We will be learning about the properties of different materials and their uses.

Humanities: In Humanities, we will start the term by learning about The Gunpowder Plot then move onto The Great Fire of London. We will develop our understanding of historical concepts such as chronology as well as looking at how these events have impacted people and places.

PE: Our PE days are Wednesday and Thursday.

In PE this term we will be doing circuits and dance which will take place indoors. Please check all PE kit is named and jewellery, including watches, need to be removed for all PE lessons.

Indoor PE kit comprises of navy shorts, a white T-Shirt and pumps.

Other subjects: In RE we will learn about Celebrations and in Computing, we will focus on digital photography. Watch this space as your children learn to take artistic photographs!
