Term: Spring Term 2

Topic: Where on Earth do we live?

English

In English, we will continue developing and applying our spelling, punctuation and grammar skills across all writing. Children will learn about organisational features of letters and non-chronological reports and use their knowledge and understanding to write their own letters and reports.



Mathematics: In Mathematics we will be using

standard units to measure and solve problems involving:

Length

Mass

Capacity

Temperature

We will also continue to focus on multiplication and division.



Science:

In Science we will be learning about plants and investigating the conditions necessary for seed germination and healthy plant growth.

Topic: Our Geography based topic this half term is learning about the United Kingdom. We will learn about physical and human features of different places as well as develop our skills in using an atlas to find information.

PE: Our PE days are Monday and Wednesday.

In PE this term we will be doing gymnastics, tri-golf and archery. As usual, please check all PE kit is named and jewellery needs to be removed for all PE lessons.

Other subjects: In RE, we will continue to learn about how people from different faiths care for others and in Computing we will be learning to collect and present data in pictograms.

- Practise reading and spelling 5 new words from the Year Two common exception word list each week. This is available on the school website.
- Talk to your children about how they can raise their independence and resilience.
