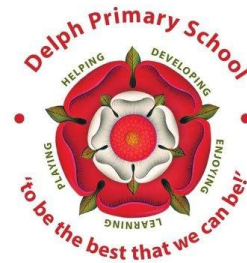


Year 1 Class Newsletter

Topic: People who help us

We hope you all had a brilliant, restful half term. We cannot believe we have only got a few weeks left in Year One! Take a look at the fantastic learning we will be doing this half term- it's a busy one!

English In English, we will be writing stories and recounts focussing on using conjunctions and a variety of punctuation.

Phonics: In Year 1, we follow the Read, Write, Inc Phonics Scheme. We will cover a variety of sounds this half term and home learning will be set to embed this learning on Google Classroom.



Mathematics: In Mathematics, we will begin to learn about time and money.

Check your child's understanding of the following vocabulary:

- tens
- ones
- half
- hour
- quarter
- minute
- second

Science: In Science this term, we will be recapping all our previous learning through a series of exciting experiments!



DT: This half term, we will be learning all about people who help us. We will all be designing and making our own fire engines!

PE: Our PE days are now on **Monday** and **Thursday**. In PE this half term, we will be developing our throwing and catching skills. On Thursday, we will be exploring athletics.

Other subjects: In Computing, we will be exploring programming using scratch. In R.E, we will be looking at special books.

How you can help at home

- **Home learning** will continue to be set on Google Classroom.
- **Reading:** Reading books will continue to be sent home, we will continue to aim to change the children's books every two weeks (or sooner!), some children may get a non-fiction book to read this half term.
- **Phonics:** Continue to practise the phonics sounds your child has covered in class and has practised for home learning (worksheets found on Google Classroom).
- Ensure your child reads regularly to an adult, please enjoy a variety of books alongside the school reading-books. **Please write in your child's home-school book whenever you hear them read.**
- Allow your child to be independent, dressing themselves, filling up their water bottle, and reminding them to hand in any letters.
- **If you are able, please bring in any small cereal boxes so that your children can make their fire engine. The Kelloggs Variety boxes are the best size for this! Thank you.**
