It is with great pride that we enter our final half term in Year 6! There is still plenty of hard work to be done and lots of fun to be had. For one final time, here is a break down of some of the next half term's activities.

English: In our English sessions this half term, pupils will embed skills related to writing stories and reports. In addition, much of our stated aims for our 'Speech & Language' curriculum are covered during our Key Stage Two Performance practice sessions.

Mathematics: This half term, pupils will apply some of the skills and knowledge gained this year in a range of contexts: they will calculate profit and loss in our 'Business Challenge', they will explore a range of projects in our Mathematics sessions and we will continue to consolidate key skills.

Science: This half term, our focus is on investigating light. We will consider the potentially harmful impact of the sun by asking the question, are some sunglasses safer than others?

Working World: Our topic for this half term will include the traditional Year 6 Business Challenge. If you have children who have previously taken part, you will know what an exciting activity this is. We will be writing to you in the coming days with more detail.

PE: Our PE days for this half term are **Wednesday** and **Friday**. Our sports coach Luke has done a fantastic job developing bat and ball skills in Year 6, so we move onto a mixture of athletics and handball. We kindly request you check that your child has all of the correct kit. When PE kit goes home due to after-school clubs for example, it should be returned to school for the next PE day.
